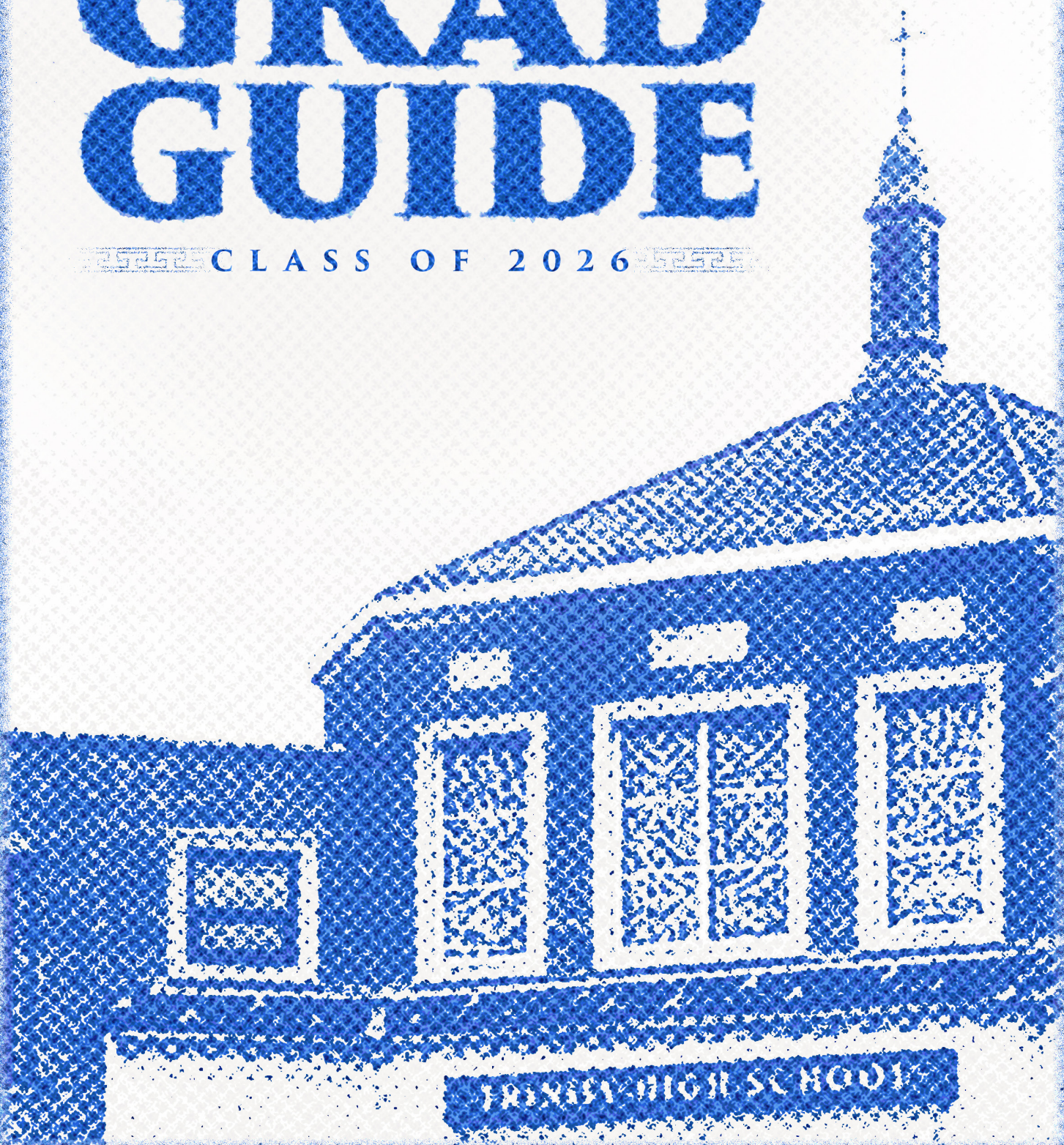

TIME: 11:30 a.m. – 3:00 p.m.

DRESS: All graduates wear caps and gowns

MEN: White dress shirt, tie, dark pants, and dress shoes; well-groomed facial hair; single post earring (if worn); all other jewelry in accordance with the Trinity dress code.

WOMEN: Dress, skirt, or dress pants and dress shoes; all jewelry in accordance with the Trinity dress code; jeans or shorts are not permitted.

Graduation practice will begin promptly at 11:30 a.m.

ATTENDANCE IS MANDATORY for any senior who will participate in Commencement on May 27.

All graduates must be dressed in cap and gown when they report to their assigned seats in the gym. There will be no time to change before the Senior Recognition Assembly at 1:15 p.m.

2026 COMMENCEMENT CEREMONY & BACCALAUREATE PRAYER SERVICE

DRESS: Caps and Gowns

MEN: White dress shirt, tie, dark pants, and dress shoes; well-groomed facial hair; single post earring (if worn); all other jewelry in accordance with the Trinity dress code.

WOMEN: Light colored dress and dress shoes; all jewelry in accordance with the Trinity dress code.

Baccalaureate Prayer Service and Graduation Ceremony will be a combined prayer service/ceremony on the same evening. This ceremony is the solemn celebration of Trinity High School's awarding of its diplomas to those who have successfully earned the privilege of this honor. The following specific guidelines are listed so that graduation will be a meaningful experience for all:

1. Graduates should arrive at Parkside Church Hall no later than 5:45 p.m. to get dressed and line up for procession.

Do not leave valuables in the hall during the ceremony because the room is not secured.

Family members and guests will be seated by faculty ushers. Entrance to the church is by ticket only. Each graduate will receive ten (10) tickets in their cap and gown bag. Faculty members will be at the doors to collect tickets.

2. The prayer service/ceremony will begin promptly at 6:30 p.m. No one will be permitted to enter while the graduates and the faculty are marching into the church.

3. Trinity has secured the services of a professional photographer to take a photo of each graduate. Persons may **not** leave their seats to take photos or to videotape.

4. Because of the solemn nature of the ceremony and the religious environment in which it takes place, we expect that parents, guests, and graduates refrain from applauding or yelling out for any individual graduate. Applause will take place when all graduates have received their diplomas.

Commencement exercises are an important moment in the lives of the young men and women of the Class of 2026. We ask for the cooperation of everyone so that this ceremony will reflect the finest tradition of Trinity High School.
