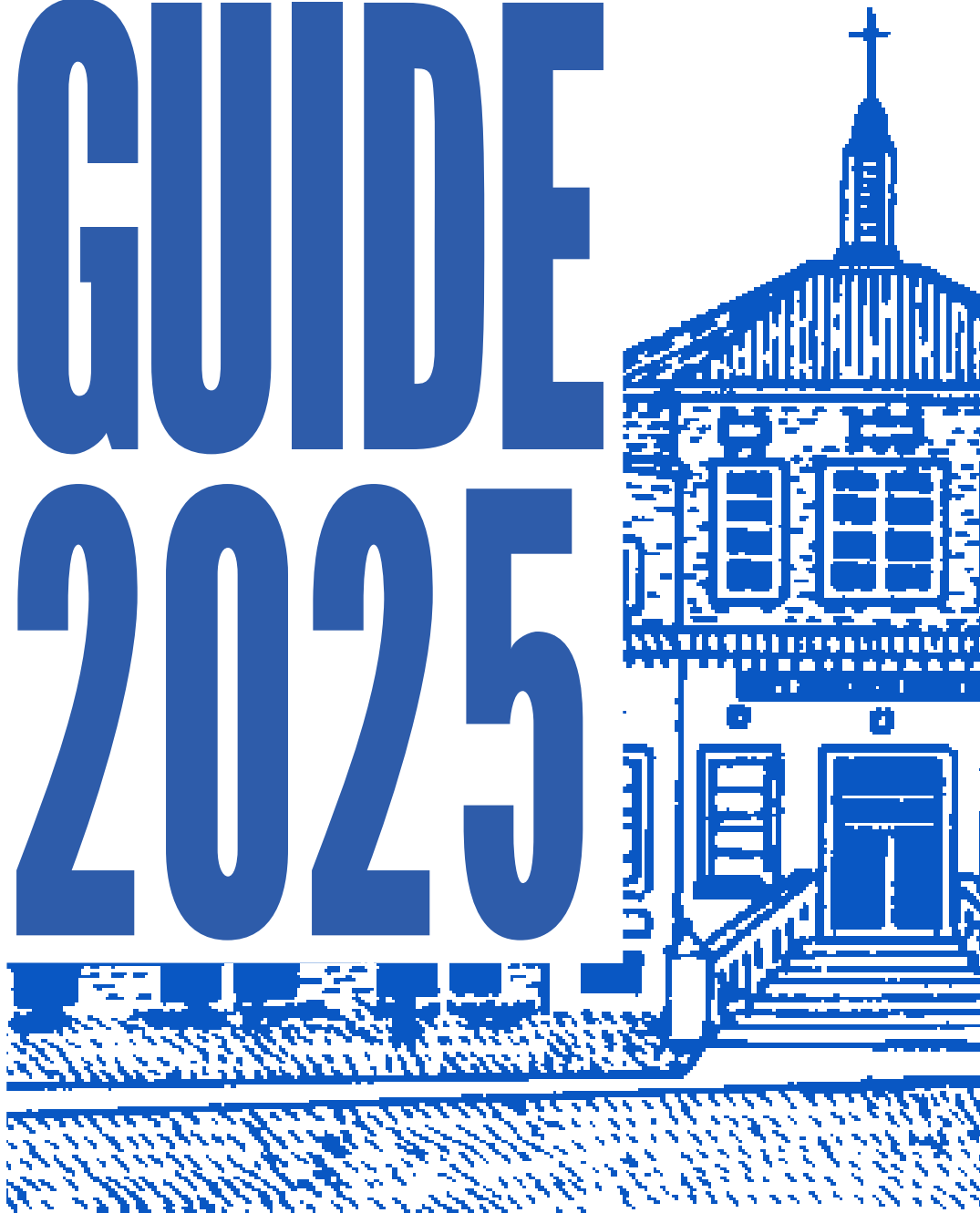

SUMMER OFFICE HOURS

Trinity's Business Office is open for tuition payments (June 30 deadline) and other general inquiries Monday through Friday from 9 a.m. to Noon. The building will be CLOSED June 19 and July 3 & 4.

SCHOOL COMMUNICATIONS

Trinity High School primarily communicates with parents/guardians and students through email and text messages sent through SchoolMessenger using the email and cell phone number provided on the school forms within the parent PowerSchool account. **Parents and students MUST sign up to receive text messages (including reminders, school closures, and internship notifications), by texting YES to our school's short code number 67587.**

NEW PARENT ORIENTATION

Parents new to Trinity **must** attend an orientation meeting on Monday, August 18, at 7:00 p.m. in the gymnasium. Students are welcome to accompany their parents. This orientation focuses on school culture, policies, curriculum, and school programs.

OPENING DATES & TIMES

Grade 9 students should report to Trinity's atrium ***in uniform*** on Monday, August 18, no later than 7:55 a.m. Dismissal will be at 3:00 p.m. Students will receive their schedules at this time.

All students should report to the gym by 7:55 a.m. in uniform on Tuesday, August 19. Students in grades 10-12 will receive a copy of their course schedule on the first day. Dismissal occurs at 3:00 p.m. on August 19.

TRANSFER STUDENT INTERNSHIP BOOTCAMP

In order to prepare students for their internship assignments, we require an internship "bootcamp" for incoming 12th grade transfer students. This year's bootcamp begins Monday, August 4 and runs through Friday, August 8. Students will arrive at 9:00 a.m. and will be dismissed at noon. This week gives students background on the Pre-Professional Internship program so that they may perform well in their internship settings. 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SENIOR PORTRAITS

Members of the Class of 2026 are reminded that Trinity High School partners with Prestige Photography by Lifetouch as our official senior photographer. Seniors receive a free yearbook photo with Prestige. This yearbook photo **MUST** be taken by Prestige to appear in the 2025-2026 Yearbook. Trinity will have a Prestige Senior Portraits Picture Day on Monday, October 27th at Trinity High School, with a makeup/retake photo day on Monday, December 1st. An email will be sent to parents/guardians in August with additional information.

WORK PERMITS

Mrs. Fritsch will be available to process work permits Monday through Friday from 9:00 AM - NOON. Students who need to obtain a work permit during the summer months should visit ths.org for more information and to obtain the necessary forms.

CHROMEBOOKS, TEXTBOOKS & SCHOOL SUPPLIES

Trinity is continuing to issue Chromebooks for each student which will streamline the students education and overall learning. Textbooks other than Theology are provided without charge by the State of Ohio. Students will also be informed of specific supplies that are required by their teachers. **However, they need to bring a notebook, folder and writing utensil with them on the first day of school.** An updated supply list will be provided online in July.

FREE/REDUCED LUNCH

Trinity High School is part of **Community Eligibility Provision** (CEP) through the National School Lunch and Breakfast Programs (NSLP). ALL Trinity High School students are eligible to receive a healthy breakfast and lunch at school for **NO CHARGE** each day. No further action is required of you. Your child(ren) will be able to participate in these meal programs without having to pay a fee or apply.

IMPORTANT: WHAT QUALIFIES AS A FREE BREAKFAST OR LUNCH?

For your child's meal to be FREE, they **MUST** take 2 of the 3 components for breakfast and 3 of the 5 components for lunch. For lunch, they **MUST** take a fruit or vegetable. **If the food items taken do not meet these requirements, they will be CHARGED a la carte prices against their cafeteria account.** If the student wants more food, those items will also be charged to their [EZSchoolPay](#) cafeteria account.

CASHLESS CAFETERIA LINE through EZSCHOOLPAY

Trinity uses a cashless cafeteria line. Parents load money to a cafeteria account for their child and the student will scan their school ID in the cafeteria line to pay for their a la carte food items. Students are required to scan their ID for free meals, too. Students will be given a temporary Cafeteria ID with barcode on the first day of school or they can use the barcode in their PowerSchool mobile app until their school IDs are distributed in September.

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FREE/REDUCED LUNCH

Parents may submit a cash or check payment to the school business office and those funds will be loaded to your child's lunch account within 24-hours. If you prefer to pay with a credit card, parents may create an account on [EZSchoolPay](#) to add money yourself, however, there is a \$2.75 service charge when using this portal.

Families with multiple students can have their accounts linked so all children may utilize one set of cafeteria funds, eliminating the process of loading funds for each child separately. If you would like your children linked, please contact Ms. Sandy Fritsch in the school business office, fritschs@ths.org or 216-581-5751. Please provide the names of all children you want linked together.

TUITION/FEE BALANCE DUE JUNE 30

All tuition and fees for the upcoming school year are expected to be paid in full by June 30. You are encouraged to pay through the secure link in the QuickBooks email. If you prefer, you may drop off payments to the school business office during our summer hours or mail your payment to: Trinity High School, ATTN: Business Office, **12425 Granger Road, Garfield Heights, OH 44125**. Please make sure your child's name and ID# are written on the check or money order. You may also pay by credit card in person or via phone by calling the school business office at 216-581-5751.

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HEALTH INFORMATION

HEALTH INFORMATION REQUIRED

Attention Parents of all Trinity students: Please let the school health aide know if there are any medical conditions affecting your child. It is very important to keep all health information up-to-date so we can provide your child with proper care during school hours.

Specific health conditions may require additional forms to be completed by both the parent and your doctor. These forms can be found on our website by hovering over Student Life >> School Clinic & Health Forms. All applicable forms should be completed by the parent and healthcare provider and returned to the school health aide by the first day of school. Forms include: Administration of Medicine in School, Allergy Action Plan, Asthma Action Plan, Diabetes Health Plan (pump, syringe, or pen), Meningococcal Vaccine (seniors only), Seizure Action Plan. A link to the OHSAA Sports Physical form is also located on this page.

All incoming freshmen and transfer students must have a complete immunization record on file in the school clinic before orientation day on August 18, as required by the Ohio Department of Health. A current physical completed after January 1 is highly recommended for the safety and well-being of your child. Sports physicals are accepted. If a sports physical is used, please submit a copy to the health aide and the original to the Athletic Director.

All seniors must have proof of receiving two doses of the Meningococcal Vaccine (MCV4) before the first day of school.

TRANSPORTATION SERVICES

Transportation by Trinity vans begins on **Tuesday morning, August 19**. Students learn about their pickup/drop-off points and times via email in early August.

The City of Cleveland provides free RTA bus passes to Cleveland residents who live at least one mile from Trinity. If you wish to apply, complete the RTA fare card request when completing your PowerSchool Back to School forms in August.

For all other districts, call your district's Department of Transportation to see if you qualify for transportation or if they offer reimbursement.
